Gateway is honored to assist you in your critical mission to preserve families and protect Alabama children. On behalf of our Board, staff and those we serve, thank you for your partnership.

Since 2008, Gateway's Intensive In-Home Services Program has guided more than 2000 families to safe permanency. ***In 2020 - even in a global pandemic - Gateway helped more than 140 families safely stay together or reunify with their children.*** We believe our success is in thanks to our integrated service model, focused on child safety, permanency, and behavioral health. We heal at-risk families by simultaneously treating trauma and mental health needs while teaching parents the necessary skills to raise children in safe, loving homes.

Gateway Family and Child Specialists meet with families at least twice per week, and they are available 24/7 in case of crisis. Immediately upon entry to the program, Gateway Specialists assess the unique needs and strengths of the family, and they empower children and parents to identify their goals. Gateway then helps the family achieve their goals, as well as unique permanency, safety, and treatment plans, with tailored services and clinical interventions.
